



# Recertification Checklist

## Renewing your credential by Exam

BCEN offers two options to renew your certification by exam: proctored in-person at a testing location, or live remote proctoring administered online.

1.

### Eligibility

- Hold a current BCEN certification in the program you wish to recertify.
- Have a current, unrestricted Registered Nurse license or equivalent.

### Apply

- Log in to your **BCEN account** and select "Recertify by Exam" for the credential you would like to renew.
  - If test accommodations are needed, please download and submit the **Request for Test Accommodation form** with your application.

### Payment

- Your application will be processed upon payment.
  - Select applicable **discounts**, including military/veteran and association membership discounts.
  - Receive a discounted application fee when paying by **BCEN voucher**.

### Schedule Exam

- You will receive an exam eligibility email with a 90-day testing window in which you must schedule and sit for the exam.
  - Make sure your **contact information** on file is current.
  - Decide if you would like to **take the exam in-person** at a testing center or online with **Live Remote Proctoring**.


